Weather: Temperatures in late June may be between 70-85 degrees during the day with light to medium humidity. It's recommended that you dress for that range of temperatures as sessions. Bring a light jacket/rain coat and be prepared for the possibility of rain.

Facility: Sessions will be held outside unless it rains, in which case sessions will be held at a nearby indoor arena. Seating will be either under a tent or inside the barn. Horse partners include 2 full size horses and 3 Miniature horses.

Miscellaneous: No dogs are allowed on the facility premises (owner has 3 dogs so attendees are requested to not bring their dogs with them). We prefer that you do not bring children – if you do need to bring them, we ask that you are responsible for making sure they are supervised at all times by a parent/guardian – (liability waivers will be necessary for any guests who will be on the property).
